



## Sixth Form Mobile Phone and Portable Technology Code of Conduct

Below is an outline relating to the acceptable use of mobile technology within Woodkirk Academy by Sixth Form students.

Sixth Form students are expected to act as role models for the rest of the Academy and as such their use of mobile technology should reflect their standing as young adults within the Academy community.

### Sanctions

1. Any student who is not using their device as demonstrated above, may have this confiscated. Failure to hand the phone to a member of staff will result in more severe sanctions in line with the Academy Behaviour Policy.
2. A confiscated device will be returned to the student, between 3.00pm and 5.00pm, the next working day. Parents will be informed. If this occurs on a Friday it will not be returned until Monday 3.00pm at the earliest.
3. Any subsequent misuse of technology will mean that a parent must collect this from Student Services between 3.00pm and 5.00pm on the next working day. Students cannot collect their own phone at this stage. If this occurs on a Friday it will not be returned to a parent until Monday 3.00pm at the earliest.
4. Any further infringements will be deemed as serious. In this instance, students may no longer have the right to bring their device onto Academy premises.
